DISCIPLINES

The disciplines included in the Artistic International Series are:

- Free Skating
- Pairs
- Couple Dance
- Solo Dance

CATEGORIES

Free Skating, Couple Dance, Solo Dance, Pairs.

- Cadet (Men/Ladies).
- Youth (Men/Ladies)
- Junior (Men/Ladies)
- Senior (Men/Ladies)

- Tots (just Long program / Free Dance)
- Minis (just Long program / Free Dance)
- Espoirs (just Long program / Free Dance)

REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.

The Event is an OPEN event but the entries must be done by the National Federations as follows:

1. Tots, Minis and Espoir: through the Organizing Committee at the link that will be available in the bulletin number 2.
2. Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior: through World Skate official entry platform Infinity

World Skate Infinity is available on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

Single Users (Athletes and National Team Officials) must individually sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already) with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Once Athletes and National Team Officials have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be registered for the event by their National Federation of belonging.

- **Eligibility:**
The event is open to all skaters and couples.
- **Allocation of Places:**
When assigning spots to skaters/couples from the same country, priority will be given based on the national ranking provided by each Federation.
- **Quota Limits:**
The maximum quota for each National Federation is 4 skaters/teams. After pre-registration, ATC reserves the right to adjust these quotas.
- **Equal Representation:**
Whenever possible, an equal number of skaters from each country will be accepted, with a minimum of three skaters per category or discipline.
- **Junior & Senior Categories:**

In case of more entries than available spots, priority will be given to skaters with higher placements in the World Skate ranking.

- **Cadet & Youth Categories:**

For over-subscribed categories, priority will be given to nations based on their results in the previous year's Artistic International Series.

The same skaters can attend all the World Skate AIS Cups.

The Junior and Senior skaters will be scheduled for the short program or style dance in reverse order of their placement in the World Skate Ranking as of the competition date.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as “Neutral athletes” following the “[Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes](#)”

CUPS RULES

For each category/discipline; After the Style Dance and Short program the best 18 skaters/teams will go to the Free Dance or Long Program.

The skaters who do not advance to the second part of the competition will receive ranking points based on their placement in the Style Dance or Short Program.

TRAININGS

The rink will be available for non-official training starting 3 days before the event. Email to contact to book the training is pistauxiliarg@gmail.com.

The rink will also be available for rent for training at any time when official competitions and/or training are not taking place.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the WADA Code, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), incorporating the

requirements of the Technical Document for Sport Specific Analysis (TDSSA), and following the instruction of the World Skate Anti-doping Manager/Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024 and 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the WADA ADEL platform and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the WADA ADEL platform is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
